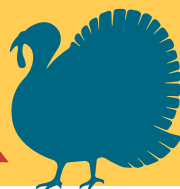

# Run with the flock at the Turkey Trot 5K Run/Walk! Race begins at 8 a.m.

## RACE CATEGORIES

Participants are divided into four groups with staggered starting lines.

**RED ZONE Elite:** For runners who have completed a timed 5K race in the last 18 months in less than 21 minutes/men and 24 minutes/women. **No dogs or strollers allowed.** Elite category starts first.

**GREEN ZONE Runner:** For runners who will run the entire race without walking breaks. **No dogs or strollers allowed.** The Runner category starts second, just after Elite.

**WHITE ZONE Walker/Family/Group/Stroller:** For anyone participating with a group, small children or a stroller. Participants may run or walk. **No dogs.** This category starts third, just after Runner.

**YELLOW ZONE Dog:** For anyone participating with a dog. All dogs must be on a leash. Participants may run or walk. Strollers, families and groups are allowed. Please clean up after your dog. Dog category starts last.

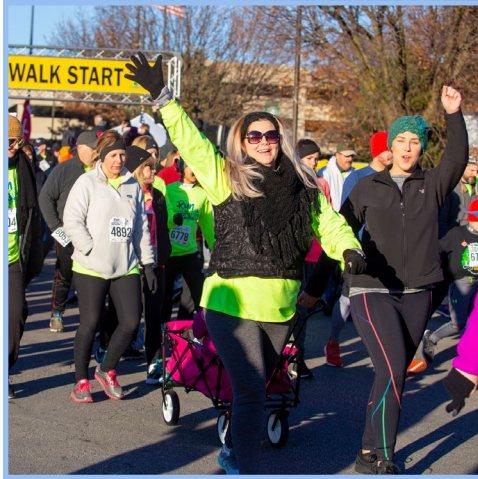

## Why do we trot?



Proceeds from Turkey Trot benefit the Springfield-Greene County Park Board Youth Recreation Scholarship Fund and Developmental Center of the Ozarks.

The Scholarship Fund allows youth who qualify for free/reduced lunch to participate in Park Board programs, sports, summer camp and other fee-based activities. Since 2008, more than 7,000 scholarships have been awarded!

DCO provides therapies and educational support to infants and children with developmental disabilities or delays, ages birth to three; as well as an inclusive childcare center and preschool for all children six weeks through six years of age. It also provides daytime educational, training and employment services for adults who have disabilities.

Turkey Trot is one of the largest food drives for Ozarks Food Harvest! More than 10,500 pounds were donated last year. Remember to bring **five nonperishable food items** to donate.
