12.	USE OF JVP LOGO OR FOUNDERS PARK LOGO MUST BE APPROVED BY PARKS DEPARTMENT
13.	ALL APPLICANTS REQUIRED TO MEET WITH PARKS REPRESENTATIVE PRIOR TO ACTIVITY
14.	20% COMMISSION WILL BE CHARGED ON SALE OF ALL ITEMS FROM COMMERCIAL AND/OR FOR-PROFIT ORGANIZATIONS.
