Park Reminders:

Just a few friendly reminders of the official Rules & Regulations and Code of Conduct for the park.

- Owners are legally responsible for the actions of their dogs.
- **ALL** dogs must be registered with the Springfield-Greene County Park Board prior to entry in the Cruse Dog Park.

- **There is a maximum of 2 dogs per handler.**
- Handlers must monitor and control their dog(s) at all times.
- Aggressive dogs must be immediately removed from the Park and may be **permanently barred** from re-entry into the Park
- No food, drinks, dog treats or smoking is allowed in the Park.
