

# WELCOME TO THE FARM!

## PARK RULES

- No smoking or alcohol permitted on park property
- Please don't feed the animals
- No swimming, wading or boating in the pond
- No hunting
- All fishermen must pay the appropriate fee in the Gift Shop prior to fishing
- Bonfire groups, weddings, special events, birthday parties, or any activity including 30 people or more must be scheduled through the Visitor Center
- Park gates close promptly at posted closing times

Check in at the Visitor Center at the start of your time at the farm and you will find the Gift Shop, restrooms, drinking fountains, and information about the facility.

**Animal Barn and Classroom:** Tour the 4,112 square-foot animal barn where you can find miniature horses, miniature donkeys, Nigerian Dwarf Goats, Boer Goats, and Dorper Sheep. On nice weather days you can find the animals just east of the barn in the outdoor corrals.

**Additional Animal Facilities:** There are additional, smaller animal enclosures accessible from the main campus. Those areas include:

- 3-acre cow pasture and barn
- Pig barn
- Chicken coop
- Turkey coop

**Fishing Pond:** Fish in the 1-acre stocked pond. It is stocked with Largemouth Bass, Bluegill, and Catfish. It is catch and release only, no license is required. A small fee applies and must be paid in the Gift Shop prior to participation. Bait and fishing poles are available to rent as well.

**Walking Trail:** One mile of the Wilson's Creek Greenway Trail runs through the park along Wilson's Creek, native prairie, Ozark woodlands, and crop fields. The trail can be accessed from the park during park hours, or where the trail crosses Farm Road 146, from sunrise to sunset.

**Play Areas:** Children of all ages will love all of the different play options at the farm:

- Barn-themed playground
- Pedal tractor area
- Antique tractor area
- Open areas for games and/or picnics
