

Chesterfield Family Center Pool Rules

Remember

*Walk, Walk, Walk

1. All visitors to indoor pools must also follow the Park Board's Family Center rules, which require children 11 and under to be accompanied by an adult at the facility.
2. Children 8 years of age and under must be accompanied and directly supervised by a person 16 years of age or older, wearing a swimsuit. Weak/non-swimmers must be accompanied in the water.
3. Running, horseplay, and profanity are not allowed in or around the pool area.
4. Diving is allowed off of the diving boards only.
5. No prolonged or repeated breath holding.
6. Flotation devices, including life jackets, may only be used when a parent or guardian is in the water, directly and attentively supervising the child.
7. Appropriate swimwear is required for use of the pool, including swim diapers for all non-toilet trained guests. Any attire with offensive language or symbols is prohibited.
8. Glass containers, tobacco, alcohol, and weapons are prohibited. Guests who are under the influence of alcohol will be asked to leave without refund.
9. Persons with an open wound, a rash, diarrhea, or an infectious communicable disease, will not be admitted into the pool.
10. The Springfield Greene-County Park Board is not responsible for lost, stolen, or damaged personal items.
11. Certified lifeguards are on duty for your safety. Please obey lifeguards at all times. The aquatics division reserves the right to modify these rules at any time to ensure order and safety.

Waterslide Rules

1. Riders must remain feet first. No stopping or rotating in the slide.
2. No shirts, goggles, or flotation devices. Clothing with buttons or zippers is prohibited.

Riders must follow additional posted manufacturer's guidelines at each facility.

For Chesterfield Family Center waterslide:

“The rider height is determined by the water depth where the slides terminate, yours being 42” or 3 ½ feet. The rider needs to be able to stand in the splash down pool and be one head or approximately 6” above the waterline. Therefore, 48” is the minimum height of the rider.” –Splashtacular Inc.
